Application Guidance

Please prepare responses to the questions below before beginning the online application. Responses to Questions 1-7 are limited to **200 words each**. We recommend drafting your responses in a separate document and copying them into the application when you are ready to submit.

You will also be asked to upload a high-level project budget showing how you anticipate using Weaver Award funds.

Questions

Question 1: Please describe your project in detail including:

- the goal of your project,
- the community need it addresses,
- who in your community it serves.

Question 2: How does your project create opportunities for the folks you engage to deepen connections with one another and develop meaningful relationships? Please include a specific example.

Question 3: Please specify up to three locations (e.g., neighborhoods, town, cities, etc.) that your project serves/will serve.

Question 4: How will your project create a welcoming environment for any neighbor to meaningfully participate in your activities? Please describe your specific plans.

Question 5: What are some examples of how people in your community can both meaningfully contribute to and meaningfully benefit from your project?

Question 6: How often do you anticipate your project activities taking place and how have you or will you inspire neighbors to continue participating over time? Please provide a specific example.

Question 7: We'd like to get to know you better. Please tell us a little bit more about yourself or your organization, why you started this project, and anything additional that speaks to why you are a great candidate for a Weaver Award.

Budget: Please attach a high-level budget showing how you expect to use your Weaver Award.
